You may recognize me as the lady who is always picking up trash or cleaning up the exterior of our neighborhood. In the last year I have filled up over 300 bags of trash since the neighborhood joined the Adopt A Street program.

From 2008 to 2011 I was on the HOA board. At that time, it was costing \$295 a month to have the newsletter delivered. I organized the newsletter volunteer program, whose wonderful volunteers have saved the neighborhood \$30,000 in the last 7 years. I also worked hard with many others to save the library.

I organized a group of volunteers to go door to door to promote the trash service. We had a good group of volunteers but not quite enough so I visited 600 homes and told people that the trash service program was the answer to a prayer for the HOA. At that time, the HOA funds were about \$9,000 a year. Thanks to the trash service there now is \$30,000 in the treasury. I am volunteering to be on the board because I want to ensure that the money we receive from the trash service, which may not last forever, is used wisely to take care of this special neighborhood we all call home.
