Household Debt: Good News, Bad News

Struggles with debt are nothing new for both the U.S. government and the average American. According to the U.S. Census Bureau, the percentage of U.S. households holding some form of debt went down from 74 percent to 69 percent from 2000-2011. That's the good news. However, the median amount of household debt over the same period increased from \$50,971 to \$70,000 (in 2011 constant dollars).

So fewer of us are in debt, apparently, but those in debt are in deeper than before.

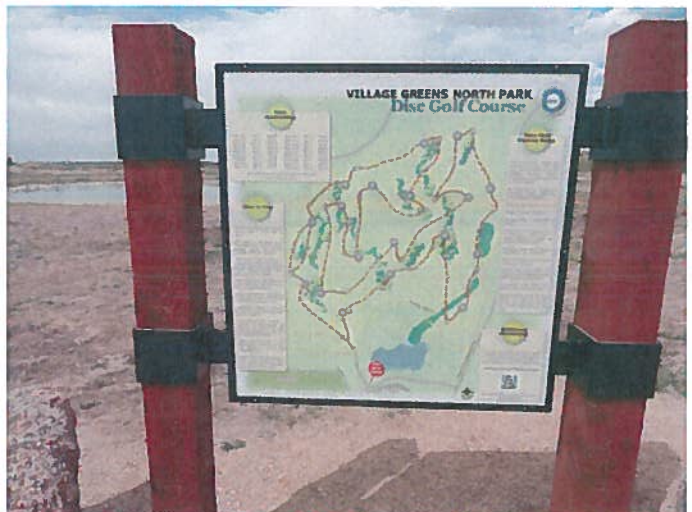

Try A Game of Disc Golf Near Mission Viejo

Village Green Disc Golf Course just opened at the end of April. The City of Greenwood Village spent over \$1,185,000 on this park, mountain bike skill trail and 18-hole disc golf course. The course is designed for a beginner to intermediate level player. Each tee pad has a sign indicating the distance of the hole, location of the basket and par for the hole. Native and dryland trees and shrubs are planned within the course to add challenge and interest for disc golfers. The course is not far from Mission Viejo and is located just west of Cherry Creek reservoir. Take the Dam Road west till you see the Greenwood Village park on the right before you reach Cherry Creek High School. Turn at the intersection where Dayton meets the Cherry Creek Dam Road. Follow the road into the park past the baseball diamonds and park in the far parking lot. For those who are not familiar with Disc Golf, the game is played much like traditional golf. Instead of a ball and clubs, however, players use a flying disc, or Frisbee®. The sport was formalized in the 1970's, and shares with "ball golf" the object of completing each hole in the fewest number of strokes (or, in the case of disc golf, fewest number of throws). A golf disc is thrown from a tee area to a target which is the "hole". the hole can be one of a number of disc golf targets; the most common is called a Pole Hole® an elevated metal basket. As a player progresses down the fairway, he or she must make each consecutive shot from the spot where the previous throw has landed. The trees, shrubs, and terrain changes located in and around the fairways provide challenging obstacles for the golfer. Finally, the "putt" lands in the basket and the hole is completed. To really enjoy this game pick up a starter kit of discs for you and your other players which you can usually find at any sporting good store. The City of Aurora also has an 18-hole course located in Expo Park. This is great inexpensive way for you and your family or friends to enjoy this growing outdoor sport together!

Covenant Corner - Questions About Neighborhood Rules BARKING DOG PROBLEMS?

If there is a problem, this issue that can only be resolved with the assistance of the City. By City Ordinance it is unlawful to allow a dog to bark, yelp or howl to such an extent that it disturbs neighbors or a passerby. The City suggests that you first attempt to talk with your neighbor about any problems. The City requires that at least two (2) or more separate households sign a complaint and be willing to testify "at trial." An Animal Care Officer or Police Officer may serve as the second witness if one is available, but they respond to calls on a priority basis and public safety issues must take precedent over barking concerns. Please be aware it may be difficult to assign an officer for the amount of time necessary to properly monitor a barking situation. To report this problem as a last resort however call 303-326-8288.

IF I AM NOT AN HOA MEMBER I DON'T HAVE TO FOLLOW THE COVENANTS RIGHT?

Incorrect. Remember our covenants are tied to your property. Every owner and resident is required to follow them despite your membership status. Keep in mind, besides the assistance provided by the HOA, that all homeowners in Mission Viejo have the right to exercise the enforcement of the covenants through a court of law (typically from individuals through small-claims court). You can find a copy of all of our neighborhood's covenants on our website at: <http://missionviejohoa.org/covenants.html>. The covenants were written to be perpetual, which means they never go away.

Assess Your Career Health In These Key Areas

- **Development.** Have you learned anything new recently? Are opportunities for coaching, mentoring, and further development plentiful? Make a solid effort to stay on top of trends and technology so you don't get left behind.
- **Mondays.** If you look forward to returning to work, you're in a good place. Spend a few minutes examining why you like your job and how you could enjoy it even more. On the other hand, if you dread the thought of going into the office, your career probably isn't going anywhere soon, whatever your job is. Look for some way to make changes that will reinvigorate your enthusiasm for your career.

Parents Feel Rushed, But Still Give Themselves Good Marks

Parenting is hard work, as a report from the Pew Research Center recently showed. An analysis of long-term data on parents' time pressures found that 56 percent of working mothers and 50 percent of working fathers feel that balancing their work and family responsibilities is somewhat or very difficult.

One reason: Many of them feel constantly rushed (40 percent of working mothers and 34 percent of working fathers). Because of that, 33 percent of parents say they feel they don't spend enough time with their children.

Overall, though, mothers and fathers still believe they're doing a pretty good job of being parents: 24 percent say they've done an excellent job, and 45 percent rate their parental performance as very good. Some 24 believe their performance is good, and just 6 percent say they've done only a fair or poor job of raising their kids.
